Directive 2011/65/EU on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment – RoHS

Dear customer,

According to this directive, all products entering the European Union must be monitored for the presence of hazardous substances. These include:

- Lead (0,1 %)
- Mercury (0,1 %)
- Cadmium (0,01%)
- Hexavalent chromium (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) (0,1 %)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) (0,1 %)
- Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): (0.1%)
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): (0.1%)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): (0.1%)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): (0.1%)

Acting in accordance with European Union legislation, we as a manufacturer of electronic equipment, confirm that our products comply with the Directive 2011/65/EU and all its amendments.

Restricted substances shall not exceed their maximum concentration (0,1 %) and (0,01 % Cadmium), except for exempted components.
